

How to upload BLC content to Moodle

As a member of the consortium you have access to 3 different versions of the same resource.



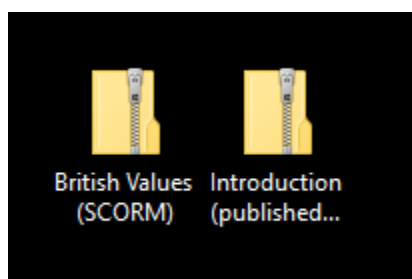
Published files – HTML5 version

SCORM – HTML5 but with SCORM compliance which allows you to track the users progress through the session and it will automatically upload the results to the 'Grade Book' in Moodle

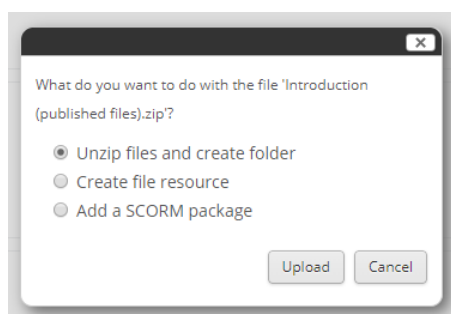
Source – Articulate Storyline file which can be edited and then published as you wish

When uploading to Moodle you will need to use the **Published** or **SCORM** version.

1. Download the Zipped files from the BLC Google Drive onto your desktop/drive/etc.

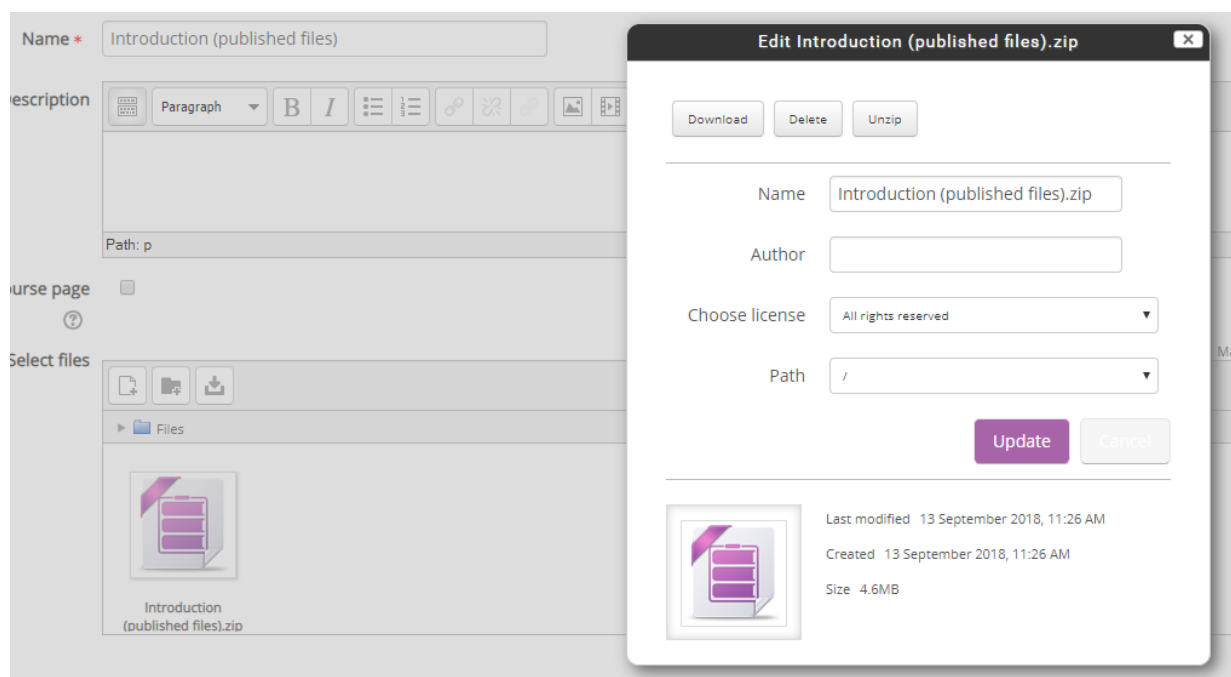


2. Drag the zipped folder onto the Moodle course you want to add it to, you should then get this prompt

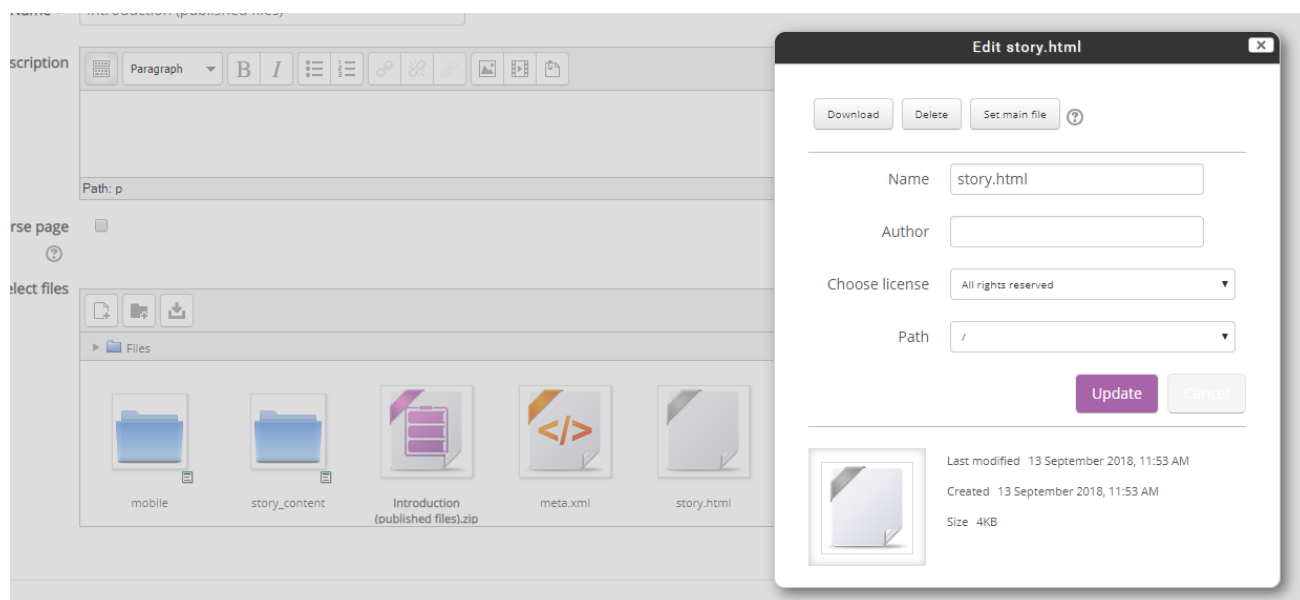


3. If you are adding the **SCORM** version you need to select **Add a SCORM package**
4. If you are adding a **Published** version you need to select **Create file resource**

5. Once a **Published** version has been uploaded to Moodle you then need to **Edit settings** and then click on the **file**, you should see this prompt



6. Select the **Unzip** option and then click on the **story.html** file, you should see this prompt



7. Select **Set main file** and then **Save and return to course**
8. When you return to the Moodle course you should now be able to click on the resource and it will run automatically
9. For **SCORM** versions you do not need to do steps 4 to 7
