The Blended Learning Consortium was launched by Heart of Worcestershire College in August 2015. Since then it has grown into a partnership which includes over a 160 colleges from around the UK. The consortium strives to improve the FE sector through the creation of high quality online interactive learning resources, sharing of good practice and continuous professional development. Members have the option to simply make use of the available resources or get involved in the writing, editing and development process.

Each year, the Consortium develops and releases interactive e-learning content using pooled consortium funds. The subject areas developed are the result of democratic voting from the consortium members, with the top voted for subjects being put through to development based on the available funds. Additional subject areas are then added as funds become available from new member subscriptions.

As well as having access to the current phase of resources, members are able to cherry pick the most suitable subject areas from those previously developed allowing consortium members to tailor their chosen content to suit their requirements.


