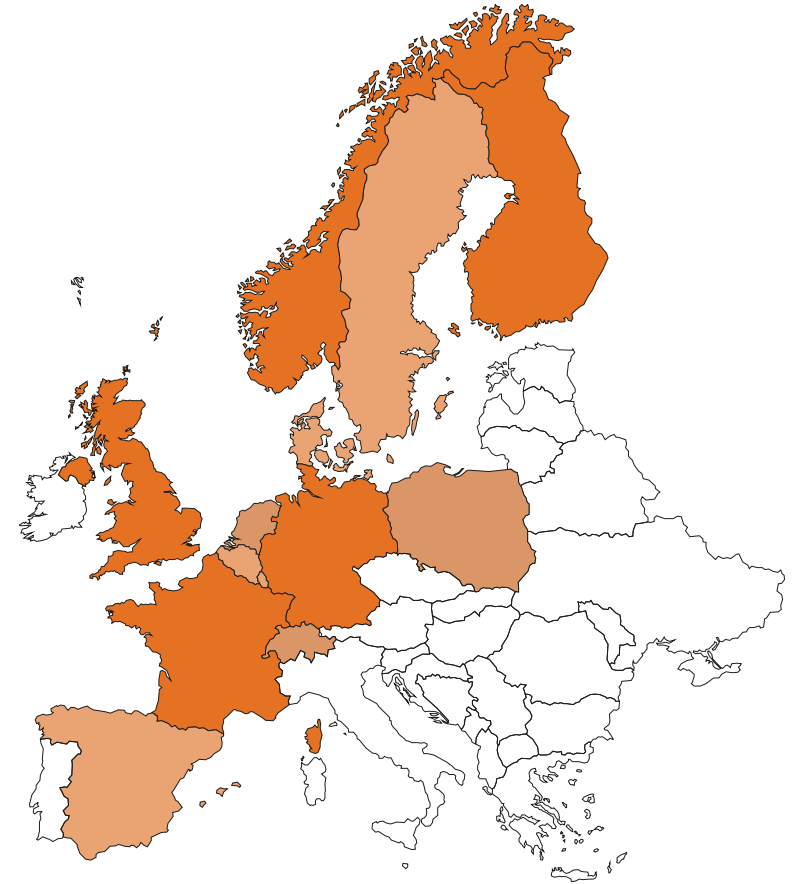

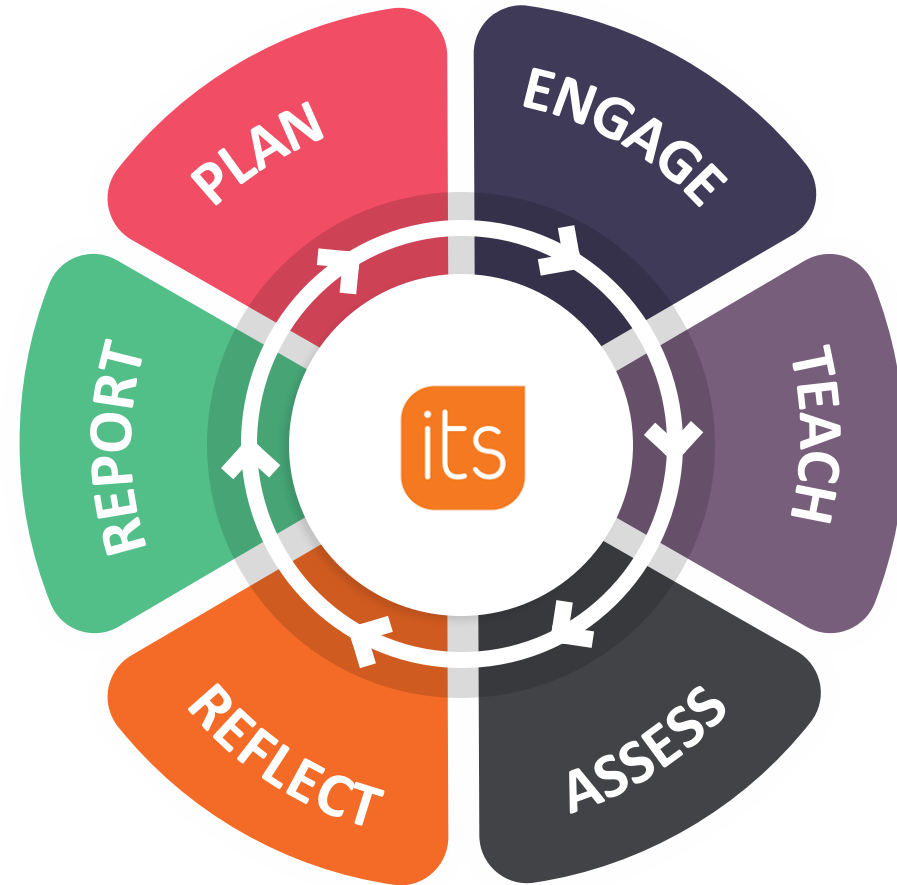

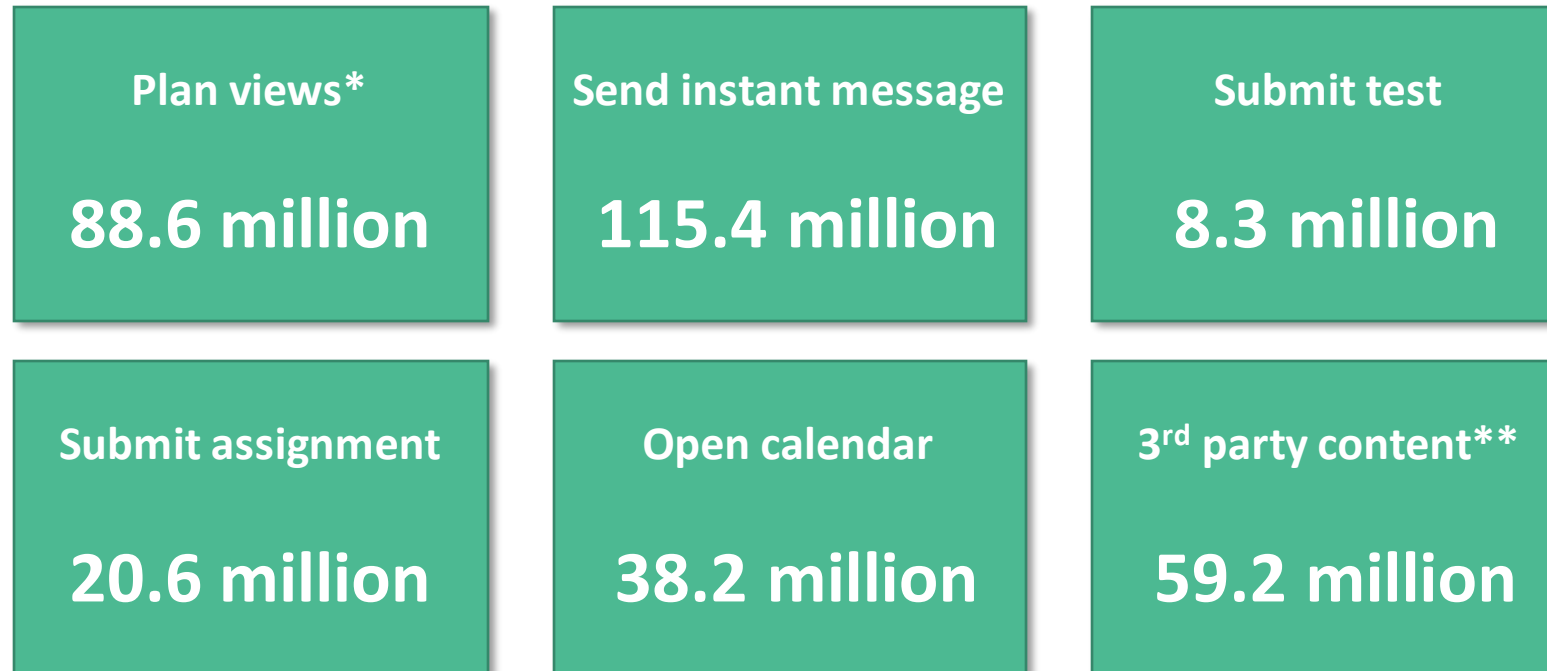

# MS Teams Integration

# How MS Integration

- The MS Teams integration makes the Course overview page of an itslearning course available from within a MS Team.
- This way students can quickly see what currently is relevant for that course. They can for example see their task list or open the current plan.

## The integration comes in two flavours:

1. You can add the itslearning course overview page as a tab to an existing MS Team.
2. You can have itslearning **create** a MS Team for an itslearning course, manage the memberships and automatically add the Course overview tab to this Team.
